Emerging Trends

- We have observed two emerging trends in the IXP space

 - The potential short/mid/long term impact that the trends may have

Trend 1: Change in large CDNs Peering Policy

Some large CDNs are withdrawing their prefix announcements from the Route Servers and preferring bilateral peering. In some cases, they are moving away from the IXP and preferring PNIs or IPT.



Trend 2: Cross-IX Service

The introduction of cross-IX service, where independent IXPs are partnering to interconnect and offer remote peering services.
